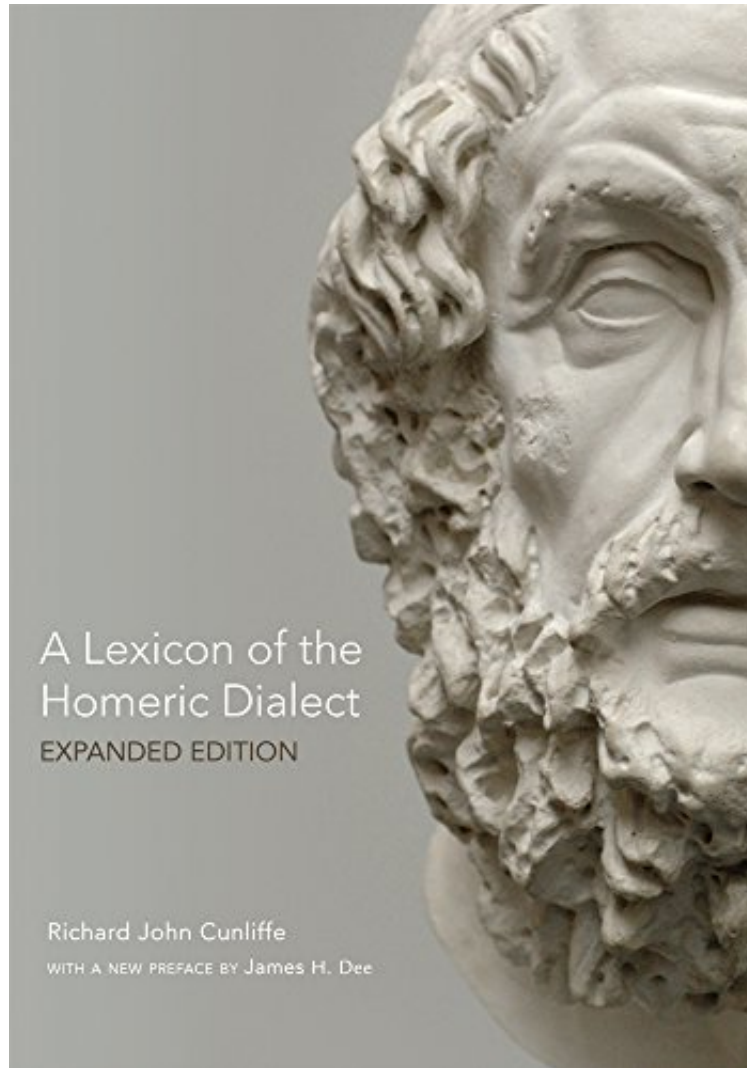

The font is crystal clear, unlike many (LSJ namely), there is tons of information on each word, a short grammar is included in the back, and it is small and portable. The only setback is that the latest version is only available in paperback. It's rather annoying to have to hold the book open, since I prefer to have my dictionary to the side while reading the poem.
