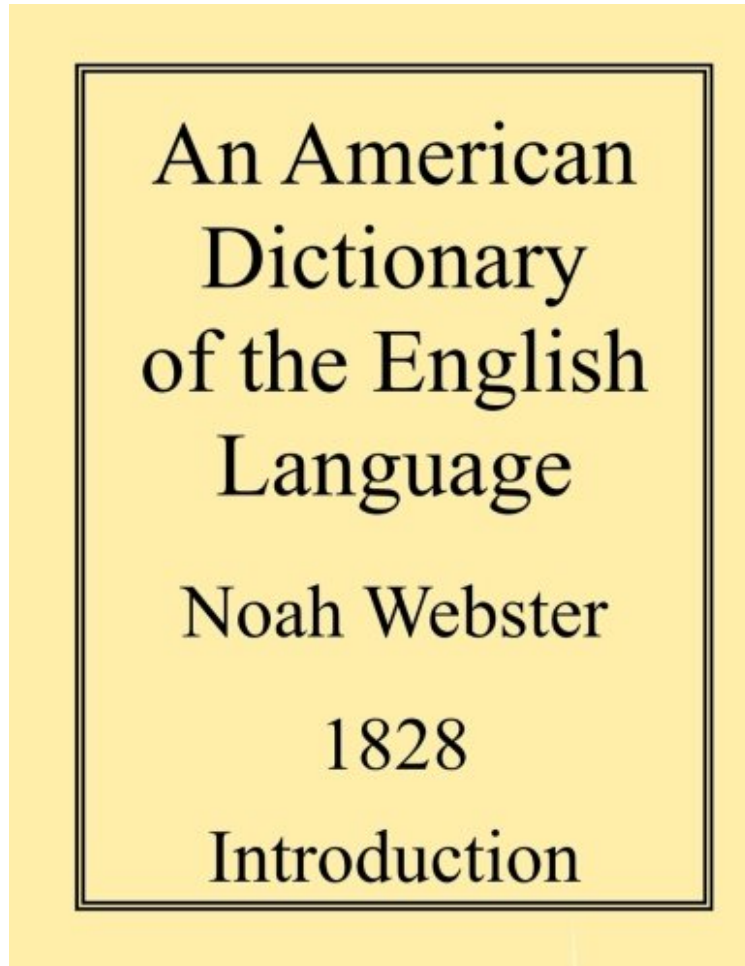

Rather than swiping through each letter to find your word, there are blocks of letters, and swiping within the blocks will quickly find your word. Example: Ace--Aor.
