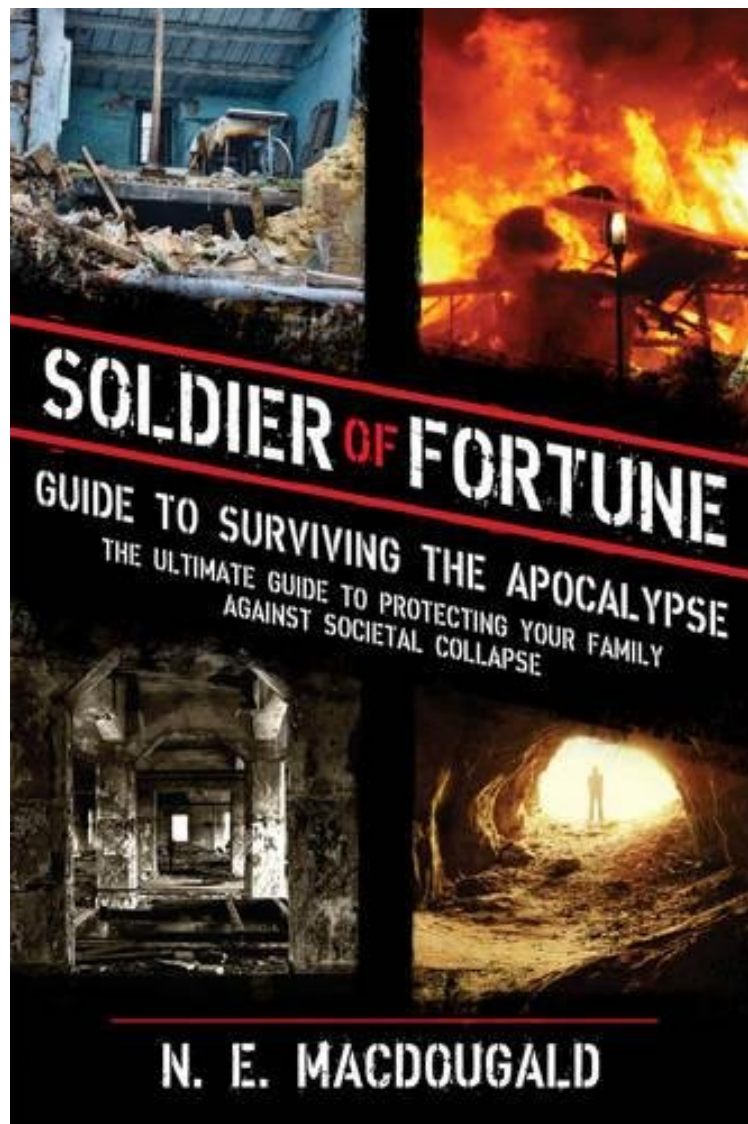

The survival basics are covered, as well as some new material that I haven't seen on surviving urban riots. But that part that really makes this book stand out is the authors knowledge of the after effects of a nuclear and/or EMP attack. More importantly, he tells you how to survive such an attack with your food supply and electronics intact. The knowledge contained in that section alone is worth many times over the price of the book. Also, the last part of the book that is called Prepping Tips and Techniques has some good guidelines to follow that will get you through some tough situations...such as when is it okay to give a bag of food to someone needy, as well as when is the time to pass the role of leader on to someone else. The rest of the book is pretty much a no-nonsense guide to basic survival, and some exceptionally good info on weapons (guns and knives) and how to choose which one is right for your particular situation. There is also a good section on keeping your family alive and healthy through a pandemic. You will probably find some information that does and some that doesn't apply to your geographical location. The book pretty much covers everything from a snow-capped mountain to jungles and deserts, and all places in between. You figure out your area and apply the principles. While this book doesn't need to be the only book in your survival library, it's definitely a 'must have' and I wouldn't consider my survival library complete without it.
